Our names are Alexa, Franny, Maeve, Amari, and Mike, and we are your chairs for Harvard Model Congress Boston!



The House Energy and Commerce Committee delves into a large range of issues that impact many aspects of American society. It has jurisdiction on matters related to telecommunications, consumer protection, food and drug safety, public health research, environmental quality, energy policy, and interstate and foreign commerce.
